I, Rose Edwards, parish clerk, of Townsend Cottage, Poyntington, Sherborne, Dorset, DT9 4LF, acting on behalf of the Yeohead and Castleton Parish Council, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by adding a footpath along the route starting from Point A at C72 Goathill Road (at approximately ST6771 1694) extending roughly northeast by eastwards to Point B (at approximately ST6780 1699) at the county boundary and the junction with Somerset footpath WN17/33, a distance of approximately 102 m, all in Goathill CP
