

I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, DowlishWake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, for and on behalf of the British Horse Society, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by:-

Adding a Restricted Byway along a route from Point A (at approximately SY 4021 9673) at the end of the public road near Mandeville Stoke Farm, and runs eastwards along the parish boundary to Point B (at approximately SY 4039 9655) at the northern end of definitive bridleway W 19/7, and continues eastwards to Point C (at approximately SY 4090 9629) on the public road at Cutty Stubbs. It is all within the parishes of Marshwood and Whitchurch Canonorum.
