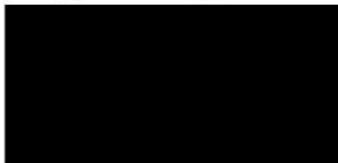
I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, Dowlish Wake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, for and on behalf of the British Horse Society, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by:-

Adding a Byway Open to All Traffic from Point A (at approximately SY 8112 8141) at Daggars Gate opposite the eastern ends of definitive bridleway SE 27/13 and Restricted Byway SE 27/12, eastwards along the track to Point B (at approximately SY 8201 8152) at West Down Farm, and continuing eastwards to Point C (at approximately SY 8207 8154) past the northern end of definitive footpath SE 26/28, and continuing eastwards to Point D (at approximately SY 8239 8157) where the application route is crossed by definitive footpath SE 26/1 and continuing eastward to Point E (at approximately SY 8288 8161) at the southern end of restricted byway SE 26/36 and the northern end of definitive footpath SE 26/2, and continuing eastwards along Winfrith Drove to Point F (at approximately SY 8350 8161) at the junction with the public road, the B 3070, at Barngate Farm, all in the parish of West Lulworth.
