I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, DowlishWake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, for and on behalf of the British Horse Society, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by:-

Adding a Byway Open to All Traffic along a route (unclassified road D 21314) from Point A (at approximately SY 7181 8791) on the road through Whitcombe, extending in a north-easterly direction to the western end of the definitive bridleway S 53/3, at Point B (at approximately SY 7213 8809) and onwards to Point C (at approximately SY 7224 8833) where it crosses definitive bridleway S 52/6 and continues in the north easterly direction to Point D (at approximately SY 7249 8874) where it meets the southern end of definitive bridleway S 52/5 and the public road at Stafford Farm. It is all within the parishes of Whitcombe and West Stafford
