Adding a Byway Open to All Traffic on a route from Point A (at approximately SY 8300 9343) from the junction of the end of the public road in Turners Puddle and bridleway SE 4/11 south westwards to Point B (at approximately SY 8270 9315) at the corner in the public road in Throop, in the parishes of Affpuddle and Turnerspuddle to be shown as Byway Open to All Traffic.

The route is shown on the Dorset Explorer website as an adopted highway. D 52104, and on the Ordnance survey as an ORPA.
