I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, Dowlish Wake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, for and on behalf of the British Horse Society, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by:-

Adding a Byway Open to All Traffic on a route known as Greenway Lane from Point A (at approximately ST 8315 1263) on the public road in Child Okeford westwards, past Point B (at approximately ST 8278 1254), the northern end of Lynch Lane, to Point C (at approximately ST 8260 1250) at the river by the southern tip of the common in the parish of Child Okeford to be shown as Byway Open to All Traffic.

The route is shown on the Dorset Explorer website as an adopted highway, D 31718, and on the Ordnance survey as an ORPA.
