I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, Dowlish Wake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, for and on behalf of the British Horse Society, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by:-

Adding a Byway Open to All Traffic along a route in the parishes of Tolpuddle and Tincleton, extending from Point A (at approximately SY 7800 9275) at the eastern end of definitive bridleway S 46/4, extending southwards and south-westwards to Point B (at approximately SY 7799 9273) on the parish boundary between Tolpuddle and Tincleton, and continuing to C (at approximately SY 7759 9226) at the western end of definitive footpath S 43/3 and continuing past Point D (at approximately SY 7756 9223) at the western end of definitive footpath S 43/4 and onwards past Point E (at approximately SY 7754 9222) at the eastern end of definitive footpath S 43/9, and onwards to Point F (at approximately SY 7745 9208) where it crosses the public road and then to Point G (at approximately SY 7738 9191) on the public road.
