I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, DowlishWake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, for and on behalf of the British Horse Society, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by:-

Adding a Byway Open to All Traffic along a route in the parish of Tolpuddle (now part of Burleston and Tolpuddle) (unclassified road D 21303) from Point A (at approximately SY 7904 9405) on the public road near Southover House, and extending southwards to Point B (at approximately SY 7888 9322) at the western end of definitive bridleway S 46/3, and continues southwards to Point C (at approximately SY 7874 9301) at the eastern end of definitive footpath S 46/7, and on southwards to Point D (at approximately SY 7834 9255) a short distance north of the parish boundary with Tincleton, where it meets the DMMO application route, Dorset Council reference T 766, to be recorded as a Byway Open to All Traffic.
