I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, DowlishWake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, for and on behalf of the British Horse Society, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by:-

Adding a Byway Open to All Traffic along a route known as Green Lane on the Dorset Explorer, and Main Street on the Land Registry, extending from Point A (at approximately SY 4728 9176) on the minor road on the east side of Bothenhampton, extending from the village eastwards to Point B (at approximately SY 4740 9171) at the junction with Long Lane in Bothenhampton, in the parish of Bridport. The route has no definitive status. It is shown on the Dorset Explorer website as unmade road, Green Lane, D 11311.
