Adding a Byway Open to All Traffic on a route known as Netmead Lane from Point A (at approximately ST 8303 1324) on the public road in Child Okeford westwards to Point B (at approximately ST 8238 1308) at the common in the parish of Child Okeford to be shown as Byway Open to All Traffic.

The route is shown on the Dorset Explorer website as an adopted highway. D 31720, and on the Ordnance survey as an ORPA.
