I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, Dowlish Wake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, for and on behalf of the British Horse Society, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by:-

Adding a bridleway along a route known as Attisham Lane from Point A (at approximately ST 3969 0217) on the public road, B 3165, south of Coles Cross, and extends in a south-easterly direction past Point B (at approximately ST 3976 0188) at the south western end of definitive footpath W 23/39, and onwards to Point C (at approximately ST 3992 0163) at the western end of definite bridleway W 23/40, and then continuing southwards and eastwards to Point D (at approximately ST 4014 0111), Higher Attisham Farm and then southwards to Point E (at approximately ST 4022 0091) on the public road (B3164) to be shown as a bridleway, all in the parish of Broadwindsor
