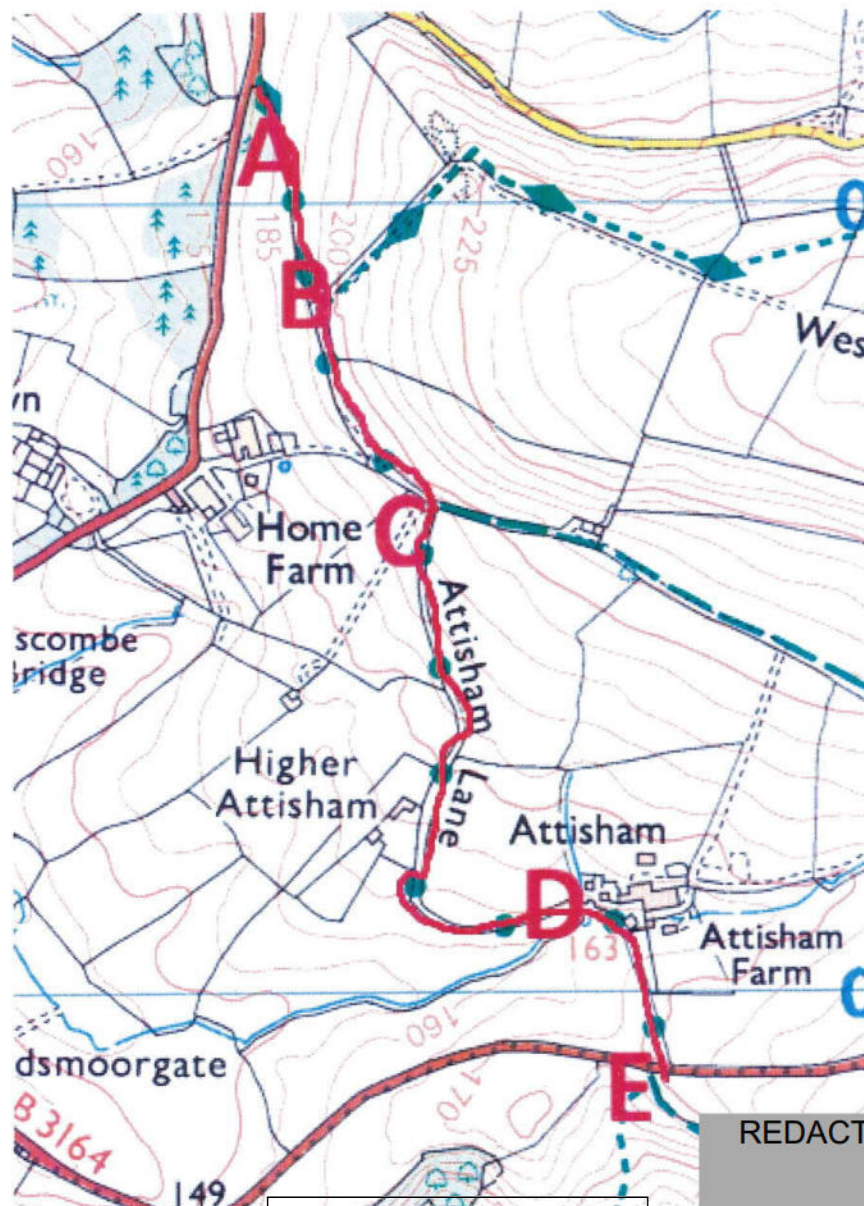


# Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981

## The Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way in Dorset

Map accompanying the DMMO application to:-

Add a bridleway along a route known as Attisham Lane from Point A (at approximately ST 3969 0217) on the public road, B 3165, south of Coles Cross, and extends in a south-easterly direction past Point B (at approximately ST 3976 0188) at the south western end of definitive footpath W 23/39, and onwards to Point C (at approximately ST 3992 0163) at the western end of definite bridleway W 23/40, and then continuing southwards and eastwards to Point D (at approximately ST 4014 0111), Higher Attisham Farm and then southwards to Point E (at approximately ST 4022 0091) on the public road (B3164) to be shown as a bridleway, all in the parish of Broadwindsor.
