Adding a route known as North Bowood Lane from Point A (at approximately SY 4475 9967) at the eastern end of the public road by North Bowood House, extending eastward passing Point B (at approximately SY 4522 9975) at the southern end of definitive bridleway W36/67, and continuing on to Point C (at approximately SY 4558 9965) at the western end of definitive bridleway 36/68, all in the parish of Netherbury to be shown as Byway Open to All Traffic.
