I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, Dowlish Wake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, for and on behalf of the British Horse Society, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by:-

Adding a Byway Open to All Traffic along a route known as Moreton Drive in the parishes of Moreton and Affpuddle and Turnerspudde, extending from Point A (at approximately SY 8049 8940) at the end of the tarmaced road, north-eastwards to Point B (at approximately SY 8077 8977) where definitive footpaths SE 20/1 and SE 20/2 terminate on the application route, continuing north east to Point C (at approximately SY 8131 9030) where the definitive footpath SE 4/28 terminates on the route, and on to Point D (at approximately SY 8195 9115) at the junction of roads south of Throop Heath in Affpuddle and Turnerspudde.
