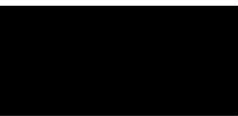
I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, DowlishWake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, for and on behalf of the British Horse Society, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by:-

Upgrading to a bridleway the route extending from Point A (at approximately SY 4713 9163) the southern end of the adopted highway, Quarry Lane, on the east side of Bothenhampton, southwards, along the line of definitive footpath W 1/63, continuing past the eastern end of definitive footpath W 1/65 and on to Point B (at approximately SY 4710 9133) on definitive bridleway W 1/62. The route is in Bothenhampton in the parish of Bridport.
