
I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, DowlishWake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, for and on behalf of the British Horse Society, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by:-

Adding a route through Moreton Park .known as Sheetwalk from a route, from Point A (at approximately SY 7886 8844) on the public road just to the east of the railway bridge, extending eastwards past West Lodge and continuing eastwards through Moreton Park to Point B (at approximately SY 8092 8821) on the bend in the public road near Broomhill Dairy in the parish of Moreton to be shown as Byway Open to All Traffic. The road is metalled from Point A to West Lodge where there is a sign (at approximately SY 7920 8839) indicating that the public should not continue eastwards.
