Horse riders have recently formed a Bridleway Group with 60 members, plus their children in the Fensdown, Parley, Hum area, as the traffic on these roads is very heavy and ever increasing in volume.

Parley Common is their main safe riding area but they fear that any of the 4 landowners could shut off their paths & the Herpetological Conservation Trust is already restricting their use. I have been asked to establish bridleways by proving 20+ years use, proving these rights already exist.

Last September County Roads & Rights of Way Committee accepted our evidence for the route shown by red dashed line, & we now claim that as solid red line.

I apologise for not notifying you earlier but did not know you were one of the landowners.
