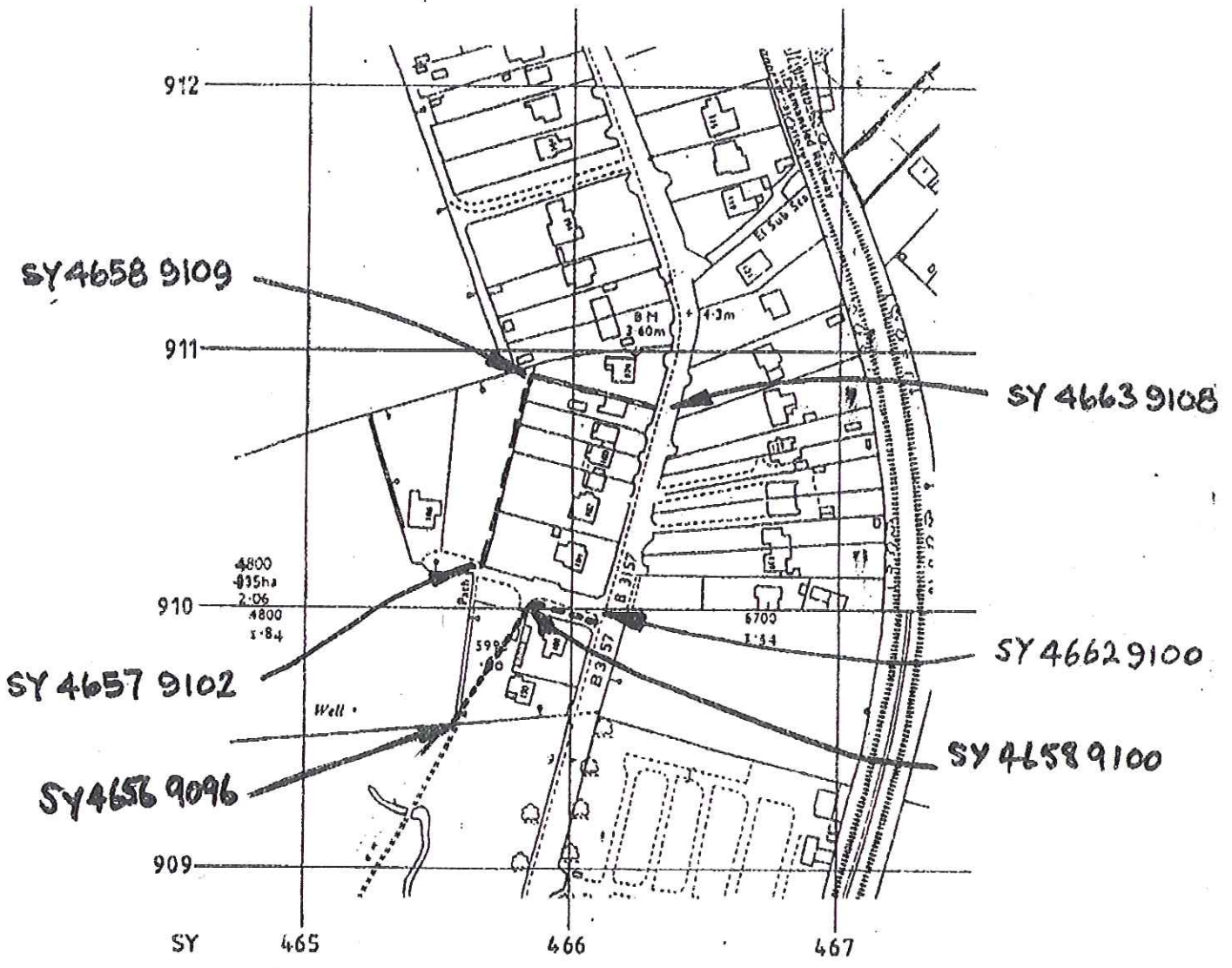

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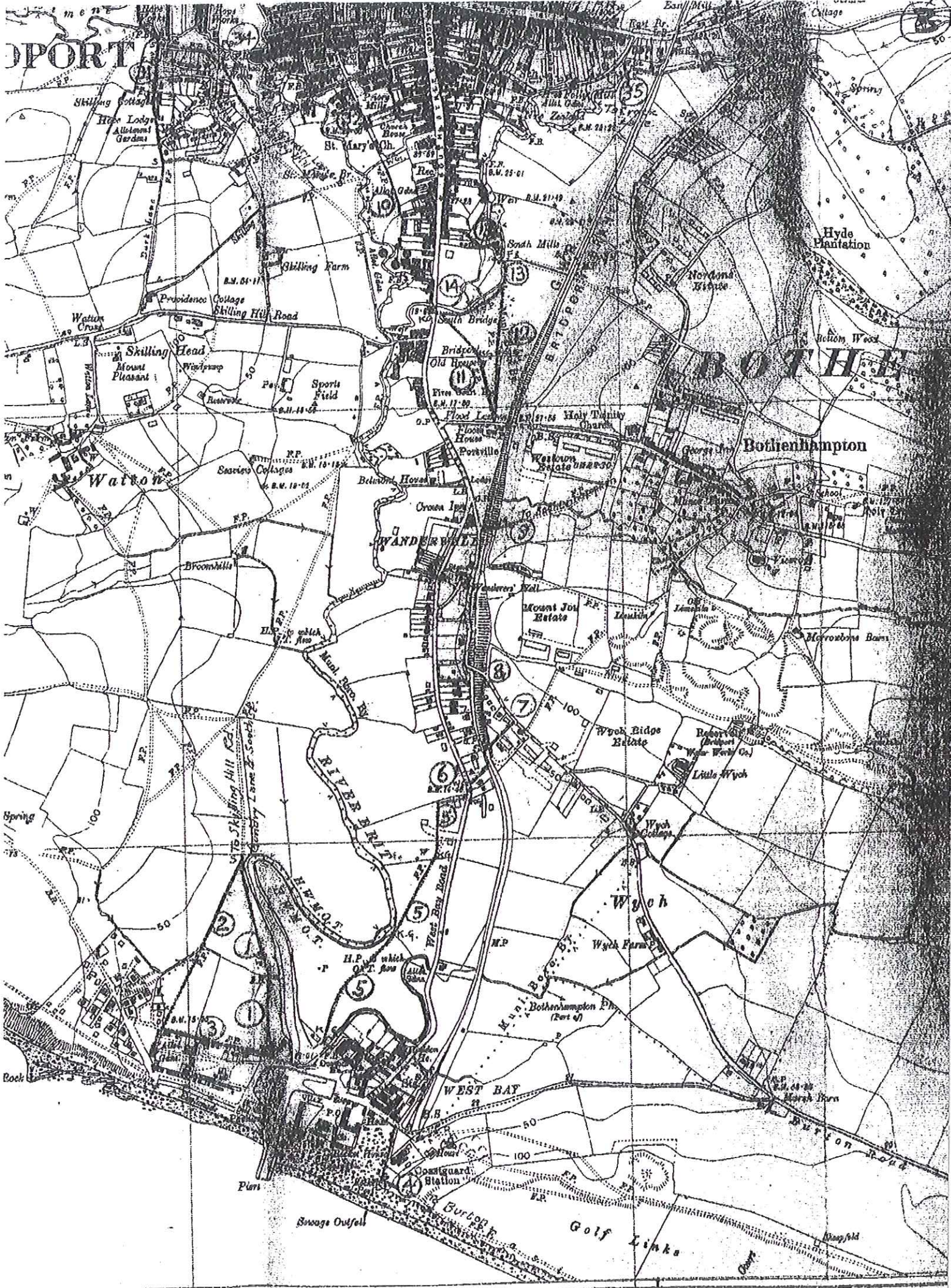

1. Commences at entrance to Camp Field with a 12' wide tarmac road for a length of approx. 420'. It is then followed by a rubble road for approx. 360' when it becomes an ordinary grass footpath up to the small stream which is crossed by a wooden plank bridge. The path continues for an approx. length of 218' when it runs alongside the river for 100' to a wooden stile which is the limit of the Borough Boundary. From there it continues through the R.D.C. area to the Borough Playing Fields which are situated in the R.D.C. and connects with Priory Lane.
2. Commences at the Western end of the Camp Field road and runs along whole Western border of Camp Field to wooden stile (as in No. 1) at the limit of the Borough Boundary. Well defined.
3. Path runs along tarmac road commencing at a point at the Camp Field entrance and running to the Borough boundary at the N. Western end of the Camp Field into West Cliff Estate in the R.D.C.
4. Commences at 3 concrete steps going up from East Beach thence over wooden stile for distance of approx. 100' to Borough boundary. Well defined and then into R.D.C. area of Burton Bradstock on to East Cliff.
5. Commences at iron kissing gate near "Riverside Cafe" across field to 2nd I.K. gate and then across second field to 3rd I.K. gate. At this point the path becomes fenced on either side and runs behind "Rockwater" and "Rosebay" for a distance of approx. 195'. It then crosses a 12' private road and runs along the rear of "Green Turrets", "Kelwyn" and "Invicta" for approx. 246' and then runs along the side of "Invicta" to iron kissing gate with access on to West Bay Road. Well defined.
6. Commences at a point between "Seacliffe" and "Basra" West Bay Road. Through wooden gate to 3' path for approx. 183' to railway line, and for a further 102' it runs alongside the railway line to a wooden stile then over railway line to connect to No's. 7 and 8.
7. Commences at wooden stile on Eastern side of railway line and ends at Burton Road opening between "Wyencroft" and "White Gates".
8. Commences at same point as No. 7 and runs alongside railway line for approx. 540' to a wooden fence and stile situated at the East end of Burton Road railway bridge. Path not clearly defined and does not appear to be greatly used.
9. Commences by "Wanderwell" under railway bridge. Entrance through wooden wicket gate to ~~the~~ path for a length of approx. 120' to Borough Boundary. Path well defined throughout. From Borough Boundary it runs through R.D.C. parish of Bothenhampton to Bothenhampton road near "Barn Corner".
10. Commences at junction of Priory Lane and Playing Fields Lane. Entrance from lane through iron wicket gate. Path approx. 2' wide throughout length and is bounded on either side by allotment gardens. Path is in the nature of a Cul-de-sac as there is no present access to either South Street or the Castle Square properties.
At its ending it gives the appearance of continuing through into

Note regarding Public Footpath at West Bay Road

The Public Footpath shown on the attached map is described at item 5 on the "Schedule of Public Rights of Ways in the Bridport Borough" prepared at the time of the parish Survey undertaken under the National Parks and Access to Countryside Act 1949. (See copy extract from schedule supplied by Mr Philip Drake (Rights of Way) Dorset County Council)

The footpath, described in detail on the schedule, is not correctly drawn on the Definitive Map. (Mr Stephen Foreshaw, Archivist at the Dorset County Records Office confirmed that it appeared that a "human error" had occurred)

The attached application is made in order that this error may be corrected on the County of Dorset Definitive Map of Rights of Way.
